



# **Use Scenarios**

## **Delivering invoices to customers**

When an organization uses traditional methods to deliver invoices and other accounts receivable documents from SAP, it can take days or even weeks for documents to be delivered to customers, resulting in higher Days Sales Outstanding (DSO). With SAP integration with RightFax, invoices can be delivered almost immediately with confirmation of receipt—eliminating the delays associated with paper-based invoicing and collections processes. As a result, organizations can significantly accelerate revenue recognition to improve cash flow, decrease DSO, and open credit availability.

## Managing sales order changes

Some industries report that approximately 30 percent of orders are changed after the order is already in progress. This can cause time-consuming manual tracking and uncertainty for the customer when there is no confirmation of receipt. Use SAP to automate sales order changes with approvals and verification that the order change has been processed. Use RightFax to automatically send a faxed confirmation to the customer, providing proof of the change order request. Prevent uncertainty for the customer and increase customer confidence by providing superior customer service.

### Communicating with a supply chain

When using SAP to orchestrate a supply chain, RightFax provides a cohesive communication tool when organizing disparate suppliers.
